

The Kletter und Boulder Arena, abbreviated to "KBA", offers an impressive and at the same time playful introduction to the extreme sport of climbing.

The hall was opened on 22.11.11 and offers 850 square metres of indoor bouldering space, the largest in Saarland. In addition to independent bouldering and climbing, courses are also offered in the old tennis hall, with something for everyone from beginners to advanced climbers!

In addition to the sport, the focus is on family and friendly interaction with each other. In addition, the bistro offers a quiet place for sharing and making new contacts.

Location:

The KBA is located in the north-east of Saarbrücken in Dudweiler. It can be reached from the UdS within 10 minutes by car. Due to its proximity to the Dudweiler train station and two bus stops nearby, the KBA is also easy to reach by public transport. A discount grocery store is also within walking distance.

Parking is available free of charge directly at the hall.

Directions:

By car:

Coming from Saarbrücken, take the Dudweiler Straße until the turn-off for Dudweiler Landstraße. After about 3.5 kilometres, turn left onto Herrensohrer Weg. 300 metres later turn left again and you will see the KBA unmistakably on your left. At peak times it is best to park at the top of the street!

By public transport:

The best starting point here is the city centre. From the Saarbrücken Rathaus and Haus der Zukunft bus stops, take buses 103 and 104 to the Herrensohrer Weg, Dudweiler stop. From there, cross the road and you will find the KBA after 400 metres on foot on the left-hand side.
